Kevin Bainey is an Interventional Cardiologist with a medical staff appointment at the Mazankowski Albert Heart Institute (MAHI) at the University of Alberta Hospital. He is also an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Alberta, and a faculty member of the Canadian VIGOUR Centre (Virtual Coordinating Centre for Global Collaborative Cardiovascular Research). Dr. Bainey is Director of the Interventional Cardiology Fellowship Program at the MAHI and the Director of the ECG Core Lab at the Canadian VIGOUR Centre. He is also Co-Director of the Alberta Acute Coronary Syndrome Group (Cardiovascular Health and Stroke Strategic Clinical Network). Dr. Bainey completed medical school and a residency in general internal medicine at the University of Alberta. He then specialized in cardiology, becoming Chief Cardiology Resident at the University of Alberta, before doing his Interventional Cardiology Fellowship at Harvard University's Brigham and Women's Hospital. He subsequently became a Clinical Scholar in Interventional Cardiology at McMaster University where he also received his Master of Science in Health Research Methodology.

Dr. Bainey's research interests include optimizing reperfusion strategies in ST-elevation myocardial infarction and population health outcomes in acute coronary syndromes. He has published over 50 papers in peer-reviewed journals, over 40 conference abstracts and has given invited presentations at multiple national or international conferences. Dr. Bainey reviews for a number of journals, including *Lancet*, *Circulation*, *Journal of American College of Cardiology*, *American Heart Journal*, *American Journal of Cardiology*, *Heart*, and *Canadian Journal of Cardiology*. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada.
