BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Jamali (Doctor of Pharmacy, University of Tehran; MSc, pharmaceutics and PhD, pharmacokinetics, University of British Columbia) is a professor at the Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Alberta. His research interests include effect of pathophysiological changes on the action and disposition of drugs particularly drug-disease interactions involving inflammation, and the link between arthritis and cardiovascular conditions. He has trained 40 PhDs and published over 220 refereed articles, mainly reporting original research. For his academic achievements and research, he has been appointed as a Fellow of the Canadian Society for Pharmaceutical Sciences, the American Association of Pharmaceutical Sciences, and the American College of Clinical Pharmacology. He has received many awards including the Killam Professorship and McKeen Cattell Memorial Award of the American College of Clinical Pharmacology. He has been honored with the Alberta Centennial Medal and the Alberta Pharmacy Centennial Award of Distinction. Dr. Jamali has served as consultant and/or a member of the board of directors of many pharmaceutical houses. He has been a member of the Health Canada's Expert Advisory Committee on Bioavailability and Bioequivalence, and the Expert Advisory Panel on Nonsteroidal Anti-inflammatory Drugs. He is the founding editor of J. Pharm. & Pharm. Sci.
