He is director of Clinical and Research/Core Echocardiography Laboratories, and is the Clinical Director of the Libin Cardiovascular Institute. He graduated with a Masters of Science in Epidemiology from the Harvard School of Public Health (Boston, MS). Dr. Fine has a clinical and research interest in heart failure and infiltrative cardiomyopathies, particularly cardiac amyloidosis and Anderson-Fabry disease, in addition to characterizing myocardial remodeling patterns using imaging techniques Dr. Fine is presently supported by the Heart & Stroke Foundation as an Early Career Researcher.
